Inspired by actress Alex Borstein's Emmy award acceptance speech, September 2019. Borstein spoke of her grandmother, who survived the Holocaust in Europe. "My grandmother turned toward a guard – she was in a line, about to be shot and fall into a pit – and she asked, 'What happens if I step out of this line?' He answered, 'I don't have the heart to shoot you, but somebody will.' And she stepped out of line," Borstein explained, "and for that, I am here, and my children are here. So step out of line, ladies. Step out of line!"
